

What is a GPCCM (GP Chronic Condition Management)?

A GPCCM Plan, also known as a GP Chronic Condition Management Plan, is designed to help patients with chronic medical conditions receive coordinated healthcare services.

Eligibility

- Patients with a chronic medical condition like diabetes, heart disease, asthma, arthritis, chronic pain, and mental health issues that has lasted or is expected to last for at least six months.
- Eligibility is determined by your General Practitioner (GP).

Benefits of a GPCCM

- Subsidised allied health visits (e.g., physiotherapy, dietetics, podiatry, psychology) and access to multidisciplinary support from healthcare providers.
- No charge to the patient, all GPCCM Plans bulkbilled.

How to Apply?

- Consult Your GP: discuss your healthcare needs, assess the eligibility.

Things to Keep in Mind

- Medicare covers a portion of the consultation fee; out-of-pocket costs may apply.
- GPCCM Plans to be reviewed every 3 months or as directed by the GP to ensure continued support.
